Background

In the year 1999, a group of educated unemployed youth met together and shared their dreams among each other. This process continued for several months. Finally it was unanimously resolved that why not they should try to create formal group where more like minded youth could come and join. Sports and cultural activities were decided to take up to start with and to influence the rural youth. In the due course of time the group decided to take up social issues to solve.

Later on, the group was extended and there was concentration of few members on organizing rural youth, women and farmers. Awareness generation activities were also taken up on regular basis. Then the group was formally registered as society under the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860 in the name of PRINCE ART & RURAL DEVELOPMENT SOCIETY in the year 2000.

The organization has been involved to implement different Government development programs such as Environment promotion, Sanitation etc. The organization has been working for the unorganized, deprived, disadvantaged and economically/ socially backward people in its project area. SHGs, CBOs, Youth Clubs, Children Clubs are being promoted by Prince Art & Rural Development Society. Number of women SHGs has been formed and promoted for socio-economic transformation of the villages.

It has been supported activities like natural resource management, land and agriculture promotion, income generation activities, vocational training, water and sanitation activities, education and strengthening people's organization. The child and women rights are the cross cutting issues of the organization.

The inter-personal relation at community, organization and government level developed and maintained by the functionaries of the organization has been fruitful so far. There is no incongruity on the fact that the government systems work at their own pace but patience and good relation maintained and visibility of developmental works done in good spirit can help in addressing social issues.

The experience of the organization is that, our organization has been implemented several development activities with special reference to water and sanitation e.g. (i) Water Conservation

& Land Development Scheme under MADA prototype scheme at Giridih; (ii) Society is engaged in various activities like Total Sanitation Campaign in 2 blocks of Giridih District; (iii) Advocacy and awareness Campaign on Sanitation and WASH issues in Giridih; (iv) Maintaining Block

Resource Center (BRC) of Department of Drinking Water & Sanitation, in all Eight Blocks of Dhanbad district.

Further, the organization was an active partner of the WASH campaign in Giridih. Training and motivational program was conducted followed by installing Low-Cost Household Toilet construction in the villages of BPL families. Declaration „NIRMAL PANCHAYAT“ in Dhanwar block of Giridih district is the outcome of the efforts of PARDS only. Motivational and awareness camps were also conducted by the organization for the ICDS workers has been working in the field. Motivation of common people including the BPL community to adopt Low-Cost Sanitary Latrine for their better health is being done. This work is being carried out in Dhanwar block of Giridih district. More than 15000 households have been adopted Sanitary Latrine facilities so far for which the organization was also awarded by the Deputy Commissioner of the Giridih district for the excellent performance in the field of sanitation, hygiene and water issues. The organization has been actively involved in implementation of the activities of the Total Sanitation Campaign in the district since last seven years. For such noble work in the year 2008 Honorable President of India, Mrs. Pratibha Devi Singh Patil, awarded in the “Nirmal Gram Puraskar” to Prince Art and Rural Development Society.

The organization has also been working with Unicef as a „Resource pool of communication experts to facilitate community owned Sanitation efforts in Giridih district of Jharkhand. So our organization has extensive experience in working with Grassroots organizations, Govt. Departments, other Donor agencies including UNICEF too.

Vision: Establishment of a self governed society with the help of local community, which could help others to lead a respectful life in the atmosphere of exploitation free, gender unbiased and free from feelings of caste, creed and religion.

Mission: Empowerment of the lowest strata of the society by involving individuals, community, intellectuals and all others who believe in it.

- To train women and men from village to act as volunteers and catalyst for development of the village and community.
- To train village youth who may become builders of their village and creator of their own culture and history.

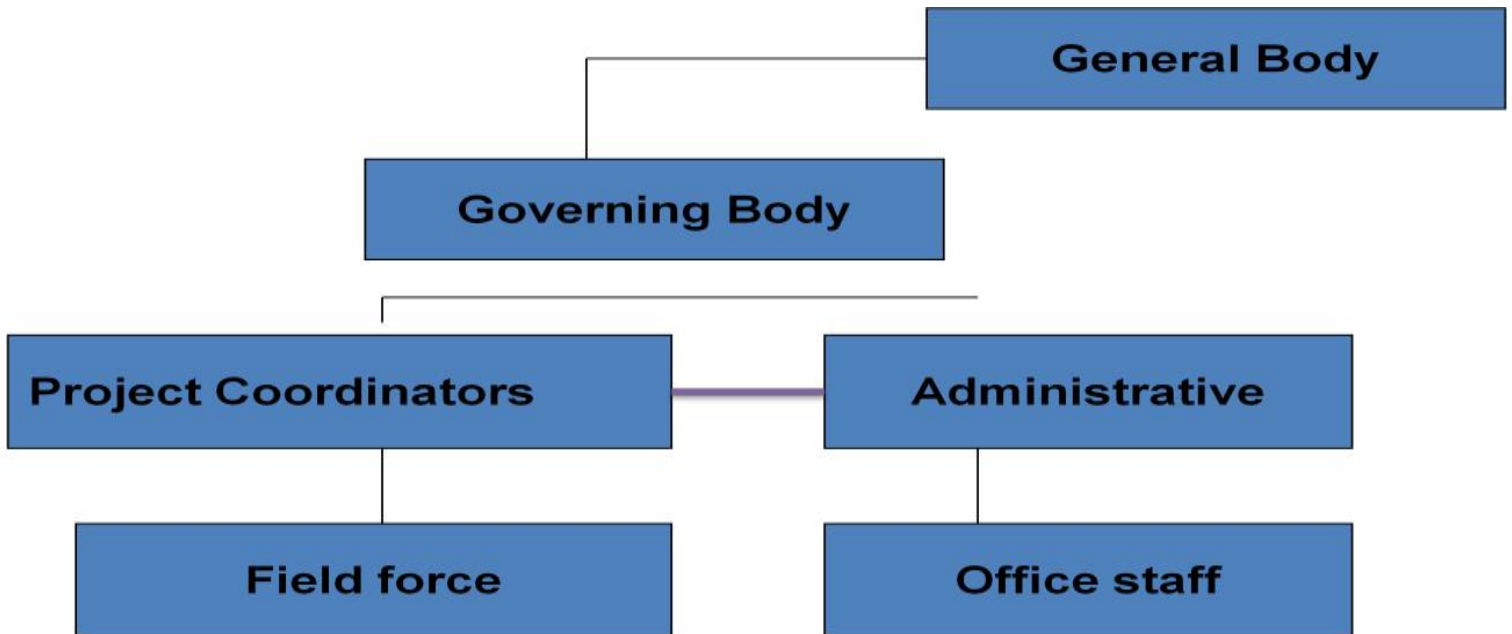

- Extending services in order to protect life risks for the poor and marginal people under Micro Insurance Scheme of the LIC continued.
- Conducted activities related to socio economic enhancement of PTG tribal-Birhor with the financial support of the DRDA,Giridih.

Key Activities carried under the Water and Sanitation Programme of UNICEF and the line department:

- Organized workshops at Panchayat, Block and District levels.
- Conducted training programme in TRIGGERING to the community members in Dhanbad, Ramgarha and Giridih districts.
- Organized CHAUPAL at Panchayat, block and district levels in Dhanbad, Ramgarha and Giridih districts to aware the rural mass in sanitation and water.
- Organized training for the ANMs and Anganwadi workers in Dhanbad, Ramgarha and Giridih districts.
- Imparted training to school teachers and JAL SAHIYA in Dhanbad, Ramgarha and Giridih districts.
- Organized meeting in villages to make the mass aware of the sanitation.
- Conducted wareness programme for the school children in he schools situated in Dhanbad, Ramgarha and Giridih districts.
- Imparted training to the Jal Sahiyas and teachers in maintaining books of accounts/documentation.

- Organized Street Dramas, Magic show, wall writings and Video show on the issues of water and sanitation.
- Orientation and refresher training to the masons and masonry workers in constructing low cost sanitary units.
- Motivation and orientation of the rural women from among the groups in constructing toilets and their utilization as well as maintenance.
- Training of rural children for taking up follow-up rallies to aware the villagers towards sanitary behaviours.

- Training and capacity building of the members of the Vigilance Committee (NIGRANEE SAMITI) in villages to ensure proper uses of the toilets constructed in villages.

Key achievements of Prince Art & Rural development Society in the field of Water and Sanitation

- Major role in declaration of Dulmi as ODF block and Ramgarha as ODF district in the state of Jharkhand.
- Motivation and training of 1730 Sanitation Volunteers by CATS Experts of the PARDS.
- Active role in declaration of 3 blocks in Giridih, one block in Bokaro and one block in Dhanad district as ODF,
- Imparted training to 1272 masons and engaged in installation job of low cost toilets in rural area.
- Units of 'Hand Wash' are established in the schools and Anganwadi centres in Giridih and Dhanbad districts.
- Study of the status of the toilets constructed in Giridih district was done.

Way Forward

Prince Art & Rural Development Society envisages to undertake the following tasks in coming months to make the work of water and sanitation more effective:

- Capacity building of the team members of DPMU and BPMU, in Giridih district.
- Establish strong coordination between district and blocks and capacity developing of the team members for efficient functioning.
- Awareness of community through CLTS.
- Selection of Sanitation Volunteers (Swachchhagrahee) and capacitate them to function as a tool to make the programme smooth and effective.
- Prepare a team of trained masons who could be used as experts in construction of new sanitation unit.

- Inspiring the Women Self-Help-Groups existing in the area of operation in undertaking construction work of toilets.
- Inspiring and motivating individuals for undertaking construction of toilets for self.
- Empowerment of the village committees to have access on managing construction of the toilets in villages.
- Inspiring school students to adopt sanitary behaviors.
- Undertaking exposure visit for the members of the village sanitation committees to change their thoughts and adopt new measures of sanitation.
